RAW MATERIAL

The Bhut Jolokia, also known as Bih Jolokia or Naga Jolokia, is a very spicy chili from which it was obtained the most famous Naga Morich, declared in 2010 the hottest chili in the world

APPEARANCE

It has the shape of a conical horn, it reaches 7-10cm length and 2-3cm width; the seeds are mainly concentrated in the upper part of the fruit

TASTE

The spiciness is very high; the taste and the smell are fairly neutral

PRODUCER

CURIOSITY

The name, of Middle Eastern origins, means Poisonous Snake: the concentration of capsaicin is very high and its spiciness is comparable to twice that Habanero Spiciness: SU 1041027
